Wind River Search and Rescue Membership Application

Wind River Search and Rescue is a group of qualified volunteers whose mission is Rapid response to search and rescue missions.

We provide an on-call search and rescue team, are certified through the Washington State Department of Emergency Management (DEM), maintain an aggressive on-going training program, promoting safety and education in the outdoor environment.

Members must be at least 14 years of age, be a team player, and be willing to participate in training, searches, fund raisers, etc.

New members must be certified in Basic First Aid/CPR and blood borne pathogens. Other DEM required training will be provided by the team on an on-going basis. Call out is based on your current level of training.

Meetings/trainings take place on each Thursday evening.

Locations/ Times are announced prior to the training via an email spam to team members.

First and third Thursdays are outdoor trainings.

Second Thursday is the business meeting held at the EOC, located below the Sheriff's Dept. in Stevenson.

Fourth Thursday is classroom training.

The third Saturday of each month is field training.

Attendance at these training meetings allows a member to meet the DEM requirements over the course of a year.

Prospective members are voted on by the team after attending two trainings and one business meeting.

There is an annual membership fee of \$20.00 for each team member.

Consideration for those unable to pay may be made by the Board.

Wind River Search and Rescue

Minimum qualifications:

Members understand that a criminal background check will be conducted by the local law enforcement agency.

Members must have no felony convictions.

Members understand that coordinators can decide to not accept applicants for any of these stated reasons, or for any violation of search and rescue team by-laws.

Members understand that they may be subject to immediate termination if members are involved in any criminal activity.

Members must have no major traffic crimes and/or convictions.

If member is driving a personal or team vehicle, member must have a valid drivers license and a minimum of liability insurance.

Members must certify under state, county and/or team regulations for individual units.

Minimum age for membership is 15; there is no maximum age.

Qualifications required to meet minimal standards are subject to change as state and local requirements change.
